RULES:

- ◆ Posters will be judged in five grade categories: K-1, 2-3, 4-6, 7-9 and 10-12.
- ◆ Entries must be between 8.5" x 11" and 22" x 28".
- ◆ Any media may be used to create a flat or two-dimensional effect (paint, crayon, colored pencil, charcoal, stickers, paper or other materials on regular posters). No computer-generated images.
- ◆ Posters should be packaged so they remain flat when sent for judging or can be dropped off at our office.
- ◆ The theme, "Soil to Spoon", **MUST** be on your poster.
- ◆ All posters must be created by an individual student rather than a team of students.
- ◆ Only students living in Northumberland County or enrolled in a school within the county may enter.
- ◆ Only one poster per student.



Where does your food come from and what does the soil have to do with it? Think about the process that food goes through—from planting in the soil to harvesting to arriving in the grocery store. Think of all of the natural resources that go into this and why it's important to conserve them.
