ABOUT THE RAIL TRAIL

The Northumberland County Rail Trail Master Plan is a public process to determine the feasibility of creating a **non-motorized** trail along the former Philadelphia and Reading railroad in Northumberland County. The Rail Trail will connect the City of Sunbury with Mount Carmel Borough, traveling 36-miles through the communities of:

- City of Sunbury (western end)
- Upper Augusta Twp
- Snydertown Borough
- Shamokin Twp
- Coal Twp
- City of Shamokin
- Mount Carmel Twp
- Mount Carmel Borough (eastern end)


The Rail Trail is envisioned as a non-motorized recreation resource that will enhance the quality of life for area residents and visitors.

The project is being led by the County's Anthracite Outdoor Adventure Area (AOAA) Authority, a public multi-municipal authority, with consultant support from Michael Baker International.
